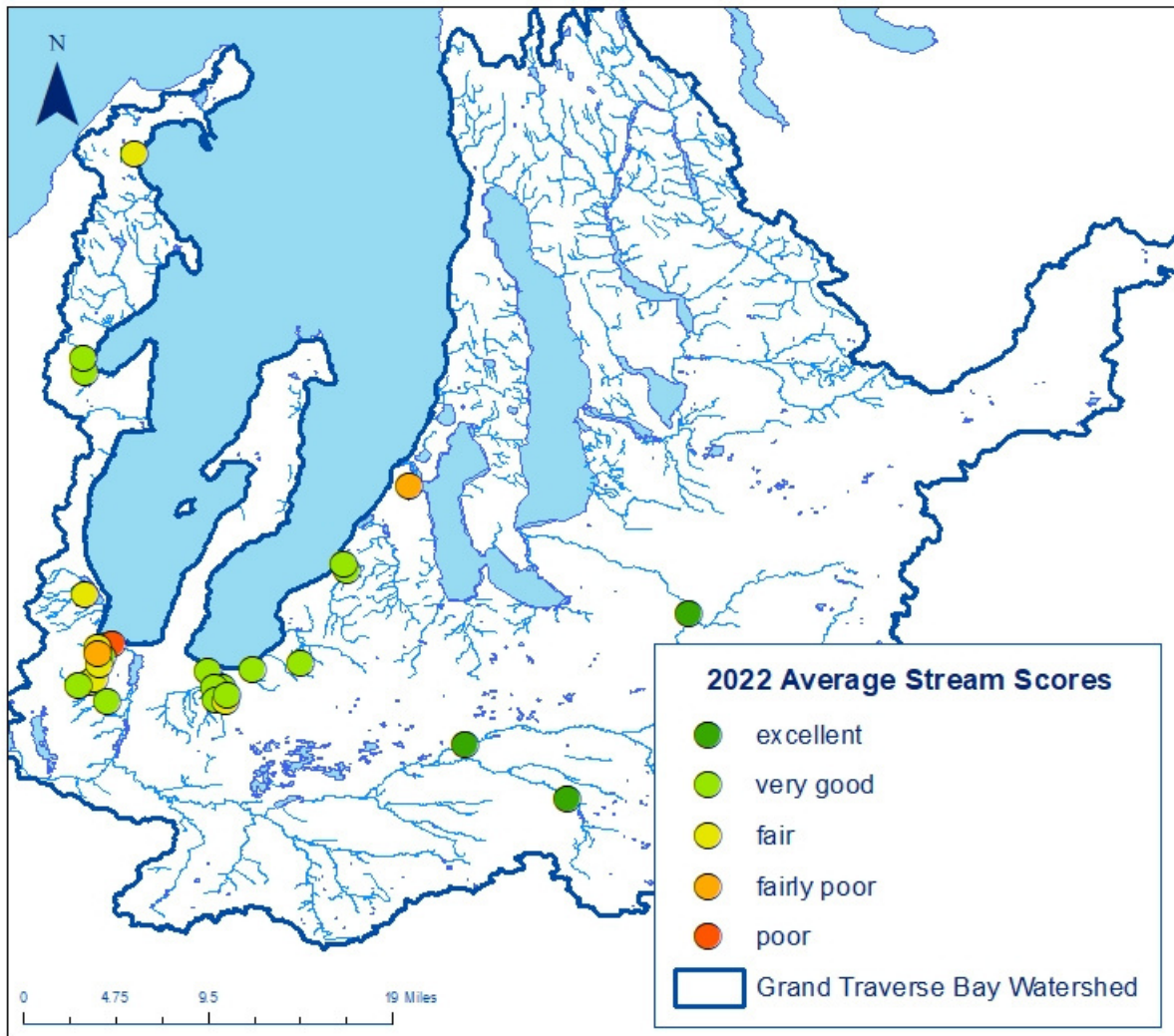


2022 Adopt-A-Stream Annual Report

The Watershed Center's Adopt-A-Stream program trains community members to monitor streams within the Grand Traverse Bay watershed using Michigan Clean Water Corps (MiCorps) procedures. MiCorps protocols were developed by state water resource professionals to gather valuable stream data on otherwise mostly unmonitored streams. Volunteers survey stream macroinvertebrate communities to determine stream health using a biotic index. This report reflects the high-quality, reliable data collected by volunteer teams in June and October of 2022 (numeric scores averaged).
